## **Synopsis**

The Windscreen spoiler is easy to remove for off-road riding. It is then easily replaced for highway comfort.

- 1) **Place** the spoiler on the top edge of the windscreen.
- 2) Push upward on the silver cowling then engage the metal hook between the silver cowling and the upper edge of the black speedometer housing.
- **3) Tighten** the webbing to hold the spoiler in place.



Spoiler placed at top of windscreen. Webbing is behind windscreen and the steel clip



engages the speedometer housing on the R1150GS Adventure.

These screws are used to adjust the angle of the windscreen.



Flex the plastic silver cowling upward to open space behind the cowling. Then drop the stainless steel clip into the cavity behind the black speedometer housing. Release the silver cowling (to capture the clip). Then tighten the strap to secure the spoiler onto the windscreen.
